Re: Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act (FATCA) Reporting Deadline

As a follow up to our earlier directives regarding FATCA reporting, the Central Bank of Bahrain ("CBB") is hereby pleased to announce that the FATCA reporting for years ending 31st December 2014, 31st December 2015 and 31st December 2016 will commence on 9th August 2017 through ESRAD system.

In this regard, the CBB requests all reporting financial institutions to submit the final FATCA report by <u>24th August 2017</u>, in accordance with the requirements stipulated in the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) signed between the Kingdom of Bahrain and the Government of the United States and its Annexures, which can be found on the following link below:

FATCA reporting is accessed through ESRAD system on the following link using the current ESRAD "Administrator" and "maker" credentials:
