<u>Proposal to Reduce the Retention Period of Non-Performing Facilities Data in the Credit Reference Bureau Report</u>

CBB is proposing to reduce the retention period of non-performing facilities data of retail customers to 3 years and 5 years for corporate customers in the Bahrain Credit Reference Bureau reports, given the concerns raised by customers who were denied services based on old non-performing financing facilities.
